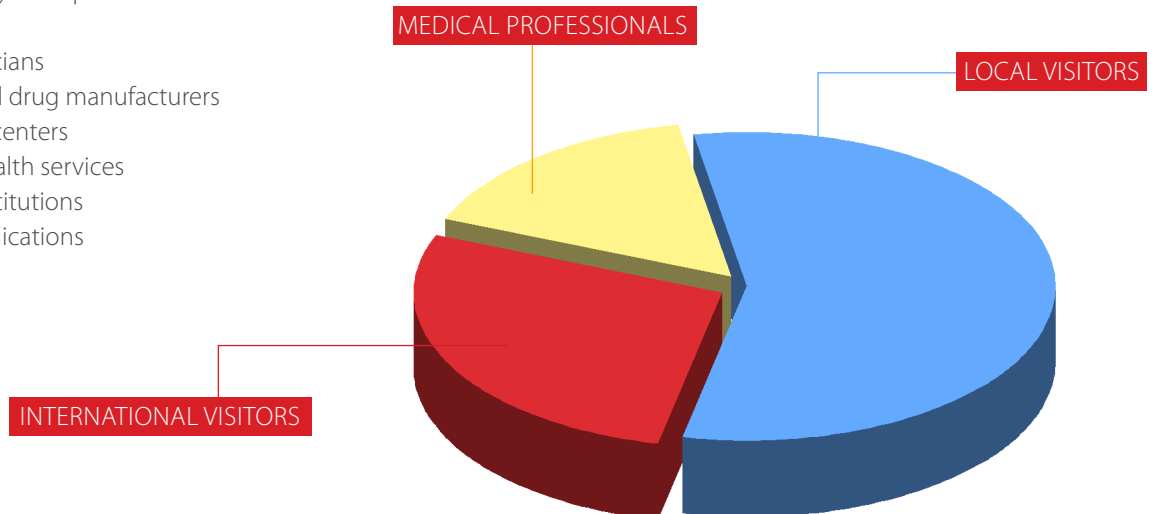

The IHTEC 2014 opening ceremony will be held in the afternoon at 4 pm, featuring a keynote address by Dr. Ahmad Bin Mohamed Al Sa'eed, Minister of Health, Tourism, and Wellness. The exhibition will run from April 15 to 17, offering free specialist consultations for visitors.

The event will feature a platform for exhibitors to showcase their products and services, as well as a series of seminars and workshops. The organizers expect a large turnout of visitors, particularly from the Gulf region.

Private firms urged to invest in healthcare infrastructure

MUSCAT Oman is keen on seeing more investment from the private sector in its healthcare infrastructure and "there are lots of opportunities for them", Minister of Health H.E. Dr Ahmad Bin Mohamed Al Sa'eed said after inaugurating the Second International Medical Tourism, Equipment, Technology Exhibition and Conference (Imtec) on Tuesday.

Sae'edi said he was glad to find more than 40 companies and hospitals participating in the show and hoped the advances in healthcare that is seen here "whether in stem cell or other technologies" will raise standards in the country.

The participants in the two-day event are from Oman, UAE, Finland, Germany, Thailand, Malaysia and India.

Malaysia, which has been making a special effort to find more patients from Oman has seen numbers increase from 1,000 in 2012 to 1,300 in 2013, said Shehena Singam, managing public relations and chief centre at Malaysia Healthcare Travel Council.

"All hospitals offer total food and charge the same fees from locals and foreigners alike since it is an Islamic country. Oman is at home here," she added.

The National Heart Institute (NHI), KJF Healthcare Berhad and Pantai & Clemence Hospitals are among the Malaysian institutions that are present at the exhibition.

Chief cardiac surgeon at NHI Dr Mohammed Azhari Yakub said his was a premier centre in the country and among its patients were prime ministers and VIPs.

Among the procedures it was known for are catheter-based aortic valve repair with the mitralclip, transcatheter aortic valve replacement and minimally invasive mitral valve repair with the mitralclip. NHI has 420 beds and performs 10,000 interventions and 3,000 heart surgeries a year.

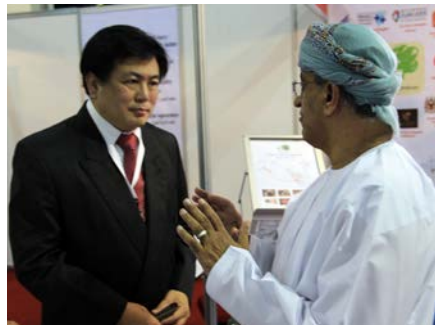
